## NOW WHAT?



### Emergency medical care and confidential securing of evidence

If you have been the victim of rape, you should have yourself medically examined, even if you do not notice any injuries.

If you do not wish to report the incident to the police (110), you can still have the traces of the crime confidentially secured at one of the following clinics. If you file a report later, you can refer back to the evidence.

If you say the key phrase at the admission:

**"I urgently need to talk to a gynaecologist" (woman)**  
resp.

**"I urgently need to talk to a urologist" (man)**

you will be directed to the appropriate ward immediately.
